THE LADDER

- 2013** A family friend hands him a go-kart at age 6. Every other sport goes out the window.
- 2016** First full season: **28 wins** and two Jr 1 championships (Liberty Raceway Park, N.C. Dirt Series).
- 2017-18** Five series titles across N.C. Dirt, Hoosier Champions on Dirt and Tri-State Pro.
- 2019** **Maxxis Jr. Champion of Champions** — youngest ever; Jr 2 Lite Maxxis national title; UKS champion.
- 2020** Two Maxxis national titles in one year (Jr 3 Lite, Jr 3 Heavy); UKS Crown Jewel champion.
- 2021** **Champion of Champions again** — the only two-time winner; Jr 3 Heavy Maxxis national title; WKA Triple Crown.
- 2023** Stock car debut, No. 28 Pinnacle Racing Group late model, Hickory Motor Speedway. **Wins in his second week.**
- 2024** Three NASCAR Weekly Series wins; a Hoosier Hero; 4th from 26th in the CARS Tour at Tri-County.
- 2025** CARS Tour surge: back-to-back runner-up finishes to close the year and the North Wilkesboro track record.
- 2026** ARCA Menards Series debut with CR7 Motorsports: 2nd at Nashville, 3rd at Chicagoland.
- Sept 18** NASCAR O'Reilly Auto Parts Series debut — No. 43 SPS Racing Chevrolet, Bristol.

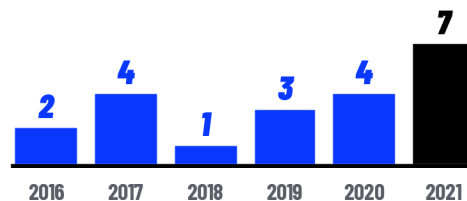
